

**All Daycare and Boarding customers please note:**

Paws to Play and its staff take special measures to try to protect all the dogs left in our care from stress, anxiety, illness and injury. We are very sensitive to the fact that these are your “kids” and do all we can to make sure their experience here is safe, comfortable, and enjoyable.

Please be advised however, that leaving your dog at any daycare or boarding facility always involves an element of risk. We limit the number and size of dogs we accept, keep safety steps always posted, regularly review safety issues and make improvements as necessary. We stay as constantly vigilant and aware as possible of all dogs’ behaviors, reactions, and situations to keep them safe. Some dogs because of their health, temperament, age, size or other conditions may be at higher risk than normal. Please consult your veterinarian before bringing your dog to board or for daycare if you have any particular concerns and advise us of such concerns.

Any medical expenses that result from participation in daycare or boarding are strictly at the owner’s expense.
